I am Chance follows the microcosm of a group of street savvy girls in the surprisingly bright, pop and artistic megacity of Kinshasa. Astute, sassy and resilient, Chancelvie and her friends take on the world, fighting and nurturing, stealing and sharing, turning tricks and making art. Vibrant and exuberant, Kinshasa itself becomes a character in the film, combining its voice with that of the girls.



THE CHINESE WILL COME

Chinese President is on his official 3-day visit to Serbia. Prime Minister and Government of Serbia are celebrating this visit, representing it as "historical"- the beginning of economical rescue of Serbia, thanks to Chinese investments, guaranteed by Chinese President himself. 20-years ago numerous Chinese community in Serbia is today hardly visible, hidden from media and politics. Same as a middle class of Serbia, whom they provide in their low-cost shops, Chinese workers remain overlooked and untouched by this important visit. In these three days of the president's visit, we witness scenes from the lives of ordinary people, isolated in foreign country and culture, which is just their passing stop until the next temporary homeland.



OPHIR

Ophir tells the story of an extraordinary indigenous revolution for life, land and culture, opening up the path for the creation of the world's newest nation in Bougainville, Papua New Guinea. A poetic yet dramatic ode to the indelible thirst for freedom, culture and sovereignty; the film sheds light on the biggest conflict of the Pacific since WWII, revealing the visible and invisible chains of colonisation and its enduring cycles of physical and psychological warfare.



IWIANCH, THE DEVIL DEER

An enigmatic presence haunts the depths of the 'Amazon rainforest, where an indigenous Achuar teenager has disappeared. During the search for the young man, his family decides to consult with a Shaman, who, immersed in trance, reveals that the young man was taken by the devil, but that he has intervened by showing him the way back to his home. While waiting for his return, secrets of the rainforest and Amazonian visions of life after death are explored, vanishing the documentary filmmaker's concepts of reality.



ZENERÙ

The poetic relationship between the ancient ritual of Zenerù and the life of the hermit shepherd Flaminio makes us reflect on the border between domestic and wild, between known and unknown. At the end of the winter, Flaminio, a resistant shepherd, prepares materially and spiritually for the arrival of the spring through daily rituals, using the tools he built for himself: he moves and sows the ground, shears the sheep and makes a woolen suit for the new season. The communities of the valley chase the winter away with cowbells and bonfires through the ritual of Scasada dol Zenerù which is inserted into the story of the shepherd's life as a dreamlike element that draws on an ancestral memory. Flaminio's sensitivity, strongly connected to Nature, allows him to perceive when it is time to call the community to act, starting the ritual.



The documentary film BELA SNAJA is part of the television series KOSMOS ROMA. The film is the result of research focused on desirable and undesirable models of behavior in the Roma community on the territory of Vojvodina. Until the eighties of the last century, mixed marriages in the Roma community were taboo. However, there was a myth about a white woman and a black man. Božidar and Suzana were the first to translate that myth into reality, they stood against tradition and fought for their love. After this case, marriages between Roma and non-Roma became more common and accepted.



The Wormwood Star is a 14-minute documentary film about choices and values. The film shows the village of Mali Klischi, which has existed since 1790. In 1972, there were 200 houses and 530 inhabitants. Residents of the village have been displaced due to radioactive contamination. The Regional Council removed the village from the register on June 21, 1991. Today, only two inhabitants remain in what used to be the village of Mali Klischi. The Leading characters of the film are a mother and son - Nina (79 y.o.) and Alexander (62 y.o.). There is a great misunderstanding between them, despite the fact that they live together for many years. In order to remain in their houses they have paid the highest price – loneliness.

Nastya was ten when a missile fired by Russian terrorists on New Year's Eve changed her life forever. It took her father's life and destroyed their house. Nastya's school is only in 500 meters from the front line. War has become commonplace. The only means for Nastya's family to survive is the scrap metal they scavenge while under fire. Senya is seven years old. In the seven years of his life, he has seen seven years of war and not a day of peace. Senya likes to climb on the boney pile to watch the sunset. His stepfather dig graves to earn money for a new suit and backpack for Senya. This is a film about the children who live in the war zone in Ukraine.

PANEL DISCUSSION

10⁰⁰–11⁰⁰ Preserving National Heritage in Times of War

Starting from February 24, 2022, numerous Ukrainian institutions suffered from military attacks. National archives, libraries, and museums have been partly damaged or, in some cases, completely destroyed. Many unique exhibits and places were lost forever.

Among the targeted institutions were Hryhorii Skovoroda National Museum, Kuindzhi Art Museum, Vasily Tarnovsky Museum of Ukrainian Antiquities, Mariupol Drama theatre, and Sviatogorsky Cave Monastery. During our panel discussion, we will talk about the Ukrainian experience of preserving national heritage, disaster fundraising, and the digital possibilities for cultural institutions in times of war. Speaker: Sebastian Majstorovic, an expert in digital history, co-founder of SUCHO (Save Ukrainian Heritage Online)

SUCHO is an initiative of over 1,500 international volunteers who are collaborating online to digitize and preserve Ukrainian cultural heritage. Since the start of the invasion, SUCHO has web-archived more than 5,000 websites and 50TB of data of Ukrainian cultural institutions, to prevent these websites from going offline. The websites range from national archives to local museums, from 3D tours of churches to children's art centers.






